- Provide your own music, which MUST have a **CELTIC THEME and CELTIC COSTUME**, Solo choreography **limited to 1.5 MINUTES. DISQUALIFICATION** for exceeding the time limit).
- Solo Choreography events will take place after the Premiership awards.

- The competition will conform to **RSOBHD RULES.**
- **Please bring your 2024 RSOBHD Registration card when registering.**
- Age will be computed as of the day before the competition. Pre-Premier age groups will be determined by entries received.
- All judges' decisions are final.
- If there are not 6 dancers in a Championship age group, that group will be combined with the next age group to qualify as a Championship.
- Dancers must be prepared to fill in for the Reel.
- The Games' Organization reserves the right to remove an event from the schedule and/or make any changes recommended by the Judges or the Highland Dancing Committee, so long as their actions are in the best interest of the competition.
- Competitors must remain in dancing attire until all medals and trophies have been awarded.
