The Credo of the Pipes & Drums of NHSCOT

- 1. Each band member must pay a refundable deposit of \$150 for any equipment/uniforms that are supplied by the band. If equipment/uniforms are not returned when designated, the \$150 deposit becomes non-refundable and that member will be billed for the balance owed.
- 2. The band is very supportive of its members, so it will not tolerate any inappropriate or detrimental behavior through actions or words. Band members will be responsible for upholding the values and mission statements of NHSCOT and the band at all events or social media platforms.
- 3. Emotional or substance abuse issues will not be tolerated.
- 4. Band members are expected to be goodwill ambassadors for the band and NHSCOT, therefore must be reliable and professional at all times.
- 5. The band will focus on education and its support of NHSCOT's mission to preserve and promote Scottish culture for future generations.
- 6. Initially, the band will be multigenerational and very inclusive, playing 3 or 4 parades a year, and a similar number of competitions as well as special events.
- 7. Competitions will serve to sharpen the skills of band members and allow them the opportunity to offer Try It classes to the attendees of the Games where they are competing.
- 8. Long term, the band will look to partner with a school to develop a teaching program as well as a youth pipe band. Once a youth pipe band is formed, they would focus on more elite competitions and improving as musicians as well as being ambassadors for NHSCOT.
- 9. The band is available for hire to play at events.
