BISHOP BURNHAM HALL

Bishop Burnham Hall, after 40 years of ministry and leadership as a Pentecostal churchman, discovered his quest for God led him to embrace a living faith epitomized by ancient Celtic Christianity, which he describes as the purest expression of church life outside of the Acts of the Apostles.


